Property Crime Statistics

Two interactive maps are available to viewers on the Winnipeg Police Service website. The Crime Map features a rolling 12 month total, with a three month data lag to ensure accurate reporting. The Calls For Service Map shows activity within the past 10 weeks. You can access statistics for any Winnipeg community on the website. Results are only accurate if residents report the occurrence, so please continue to report any crimes that occur. Anecdotal comments from neighbours suggest that property crimes have been increasing over the last 2 years in Earl Grey, but not so much in Ebby Wentworth.

Back Lane Property Numbers

The EGNSA is pleased to provide interested residents with free peel and stick property numbers to be used to identify your property from the back lane. Having your address visible from the back lane is important to allow first responders to identify your property in case of an emergency. September Tree Banding

Tree banding for cankerworm control is one way residents can help preserve our boulevard trees. It is best if the entire block is banded or else cankerworms can bridge between treetops and infect adjacent trees. The EGNSA is continuing our tree banding service this year. The cost is \$10 per property to band all of the boulevard trees on a block. For an additional fee, we will also band trees on your private property.

We will be working with our block organizers to determine interest on blocks throughout the neighbourhood. Block organizers poll residents on their block and collect the fees. We are always looking for more block organizers!
